Everyone knows that in this day and age, it can be very easy to keep in touch with friends...all you need is a mailing address, a telephone number or an email address. Buddy Tags are a fun way for campers to collect this information from the many new friends they'll make during camp (and their old friends too) and stay in touch after camp is over. This swapping of contact information is an added bonus now that HIPAA regulations prohibit camps from sharing camper information among families.

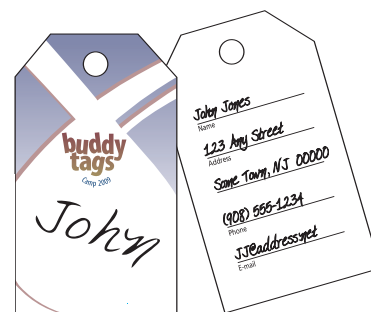
Here's what each camp will receive:

**1** Custom-made Buddy Tag holders for each camper made up of one program tag (where the campers can ID their set of Buddy Tags) and 25 Buddy Tags. The campers can record their contact information on each of the 25 Buddy Tags and then swap them with their friends at camp. Each camper will return home with contact information for up to 25 buddies.

**2** Sets of colored pencils and black ink pens will be available for the campers to fill out their Buddy Tags. They'll also have the opportunity to decorate the tags if they wish.
